Article 13

Transportation of all works will be at the expenses of the participants.

Article 14 :

The organiser will not be held responsible for any damage while the works are in transit. All works received in Seychelles will be handled with care.

Article 15 :

All works must be individual and must have been done during 2007 and must not have been previously exhibited.

Article 16 :

The decisions of the jury is final, no appeal or correspondance will be entered into.

Article 17 :

All works become the property of the Seychelles Creole Festival secretariat. The secretariat reserves the right to use reproductions of the works in promotional materials.

Article 18 :

All products must reach the addresses below no later than 30th August 2007.

Article 1:

Within the framework of creole festival which takes place annually in Seychelles, during the last week of October, an art competition entitled ‘Young Artists of the Creole World’ is organised.

Article 2 :

All works received which meet the deadline and conform to the regulations will be presented at an exhibition during which the results of the competition will be announced. All winners will receive a certificate.

Article 3 :

The competition is open to young people between the age of 4 to 21 years who originate from the Creolophone islands, territories or states or are apart of Creole tradition.

Article 4

Entrants may also include:

- * Young people originating from Creole communities who live outside their native territory or country.
- * Upon the specific invitation of the Creole Festival national committee, young people originating from countries bordering the Indian Ocean.

Article 5 :

Participants are free to choose any technique such as: collage, oil, acrylic, watercolor, gouache, pastel, colored crayons, markers or ink.

Article 6 :

The theme is “lets celebrate our Creolity”

The sub-theme are as follows:

4 to 7 years- **games**

8 to 12 years-**games**

13 to 17 years- **colors of the market**

18 to 21 years- **freindship**

Article 7 :

The paintings should measure: :

- * no bigger than A2-420mm x 594mm
- * no smaller than A4-210mm x 297mm

The sculptures should have measurements not longer than 60cm and not smaller than 15cm.

Article 8 :

The following information should be indicated at the back of the work:

COUNTRY, SURNAME, FIRST NAME, AGE, GENDER, ADDRESS, TITLE OF WORK, CATEGORY OF ENTRY, SCHOOL/ WORKING PLACE.

Article 9 :

Works will be classified as follows:

- Category A : 4 to 7 years
- Category B : 8 to 12 years
- Category C : 13 to 17 years
- Category D : 18 to 21 years

Article 10 :

The selection criteria of the works will be based on the comprehension and the interpretation of the theme and sub themes proposed in each category, on the organization of the visual elements vis a vis the originality, novelty, artistic techniques and sensitivity to express and create.

Article 11:

The award of more than one prize is not permitted. Each category will be awarded a first and second prize.

The first prize in each category is a “coco de mer” trophy, certificate and promotional item from Seychelles such as CD, DVD, books.

The second prize in each category is a trophy in the shape of a coco de mer, certificate and promotional item from Seychelles such as CD, DVD, books.
